

Eastern Coachella valley (I What is fugitive dust?

- In the ECV, particulate matter (PM10) is primarily comprised of windblown dust from dirt on paved and unpaved roads, agricultural tilling and land development activities.
- Fugitive dust is PM10 that is suspended in the air.

How to reduce exposure to fugitive dust

- Check the air quality in your area by visiting <u>www.aqmd.gov/aqimap</u> or the South Coast AQMD mobile app.
- Limit the amount of time you and your loved ones spend outdoors in PM10 levels are high.
