Compliance Test Protocols or Reports Routing

Compliance Test Protocols or Reports shall not be mailed directly to the Source Testing & Engineering Branch (STE). Sending Compliance protocols and reports to STE will delay the evaluation process, and may subject facilities to enforcement action (even if the document is submitted prior to a deadline). Testing laboratories shall also adhere to this requirement, if they are submitting protocols and reports on behalf of the facility.

It should be noted however, that all CEMS related test reports (certification tests, RATAs, etc.) should continue to be mailed to the STE branch. Finally, if feasible, please submit RATA results using SCAQMD's Electronic Data Reporting (EDR).
