

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM THE CALIFORNIA

**ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT** 

PROJECT TITLE: PROPOSED AMENDED RULE 1143 – CONSUMER PAINT

THINNERS AND MULTI-PURPOSE SOLVENTS

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is the Lead Agency and has prepared a Notice of Exemption for the project identified above.

The SCAQMD has reviewed the proposed project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15002 (k)(1), the first step of a three-step process for deciding which document to prepare for a project subject to CEQA. Based upon staff's review, it has been determined that the proposed amendments are exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15268 – Ministerial Projects. The proposed project consists of rescinding the VOC limit of 25 grams per liter (g/L) for paint thinners and multi-purpose solvents to comply with the judgment issued by the Los Angeles County Superior Court on April 1, 2010. Because the SCAQMD has no discretion with regard to the proposed project, it is considered to be ministerially exempt.

A Notice of Exemption has been prepared pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15062 - Notice of Exemption. If approved, the Notice of Exemption will be filed with the county clerks of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties.
