
Preliminary Compound Exclusion Concept ACA Comments




Film Extraction

- Too complicated
- Not accurate
- Associated errors could result in compound be treated as a VOC
- Film extraction procedure seems only appropriate for latex architectural coatings
- However Rule 1113 includes many other types of coatings
- Method 313 is intended for other coatings rules
- Suggest Pentaethylene Glycol instead of Dibutyl Phthalate



TGA or Method 24

- ACA suggests using either TGA or Method 24 as second step as opposed to film extraction
- ACA is open to lower temperatures which are more representative of AIM coatings applications
- Correlate better to District's ambient solvent evaporation results
- Rule 1144
- Utilize fully formulated coating and/or resin



Method 313

- ACA requests SCAQMD include precision statements in Method 313
- Users can then complete confidence limit calculations
