## **ADVISORY NOTICE**

<u>Rule 1113</u> :	Section (d) Paragraph (3)(B)
Original Review:	February 2007
Revised Date:	November 2013
Subject:	Specification of Product Labeling for Multi-Component Coatings

## Issue:

The South Coast Air Quality Management District has been made aware of an uncertainty in the labeling requirements for multi-component coatings.

## Current Rule Language:

Rule 1113 requires labeling for all products subject to the rule.

Section (d)(3)(B) states that each container of any coating subject to the rule the maximum VOC content in grams per liter as follows:

For multi-component coatings, the VOC per liter of coating (less water and exempt compounds, and excluding any colorant added to the tint base) after mixing the components, as recommended for use by the architectural coatings manufacturer;

## **Conclusion:**

Containers of multi-component coatings, and any associated product literature, shall indicate the total system VOC as recommended for application by the manufacturer, if packaged together. If individual containers are sold, then each container must indicate total system VOC.
